

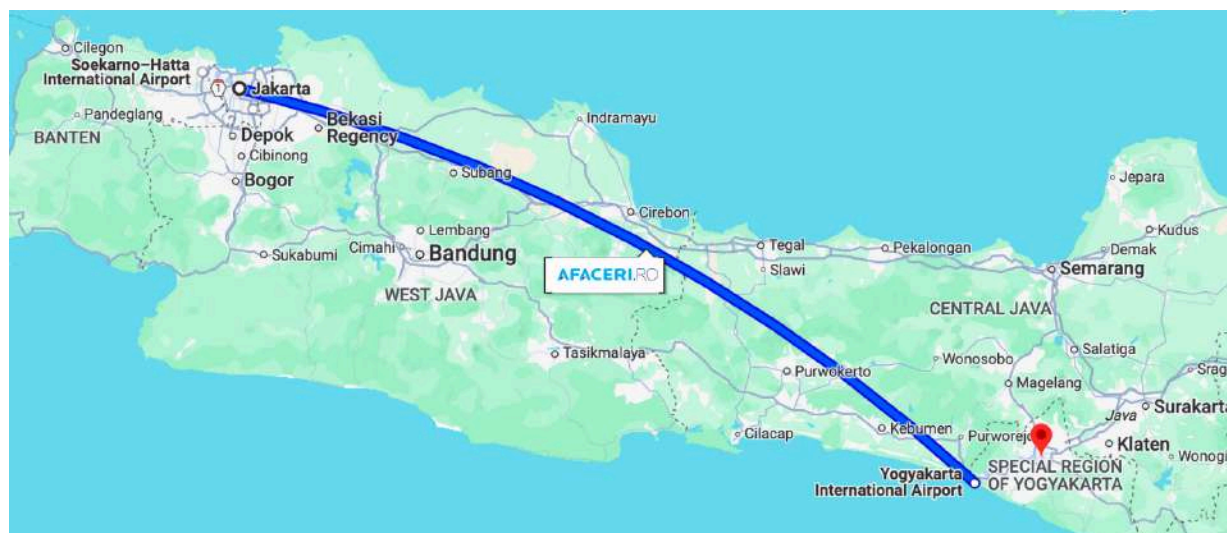

- Visit Kraton Yogyakarta, or **Sultan's Palace**, a cultural gem in the heart of Yogyakarta. Built in 1755, this living museum is the residence of the Sultan of Yogyakarta and showcases Javanese royal heritage. Visitors are drawn to its elegant pavilions, intricate carvings, and the museum displaying royal artifacts, batik, and gamelan instruments.

- **Taman Sari Water Castle**, a short 10-minute walk from Kraton Yogyakarta, is a captivating 18th-century royal retreat blending Javanese and European architectural styles. Built in 1758 by Sultan Hamengkubuwono I and once a pleasure park with artificial lakes, it's now partly occupied by Kampung Taman village.

Meeting with the local guide and departing for a **full-day tour** of the Borobudur's Temples and surroundings.

- *located on top of a hill near the town of Magelang, **Borobudur** is an ancient Buddhist stupa and temple complex in Central Java, Indonesia. This impressive UNESCO World Heritage Site dates back to the 8th century and is the largest buddhist monument in the world. The complex is surrounded by an impossibly scenic landscape featuring active volcanoes, dramatic limestone cliffs, lush green rice fields and traditional rice-growing villages. It covers a massive area and is multi-tiered and intricately decorated with 2,672 relief panels and 504 Buddha statues. Interestingly, the temple was constructed without the use of any kind of cement or*

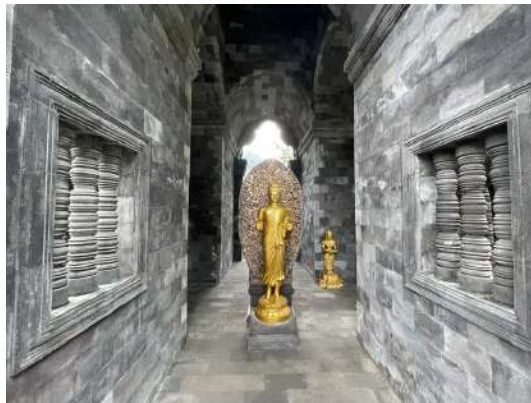

mortar as it was cleverly designed as a series of massive interlocking blocks.



- **Mendut Temple** is a 9th Century Buddhist temple situated in the village of Mendut, Indonesia. The temple features a square base, Makara statues, a carved fable of a Buddhist teaching, large stone statues, and the outside is decorated Buddhist divinities.

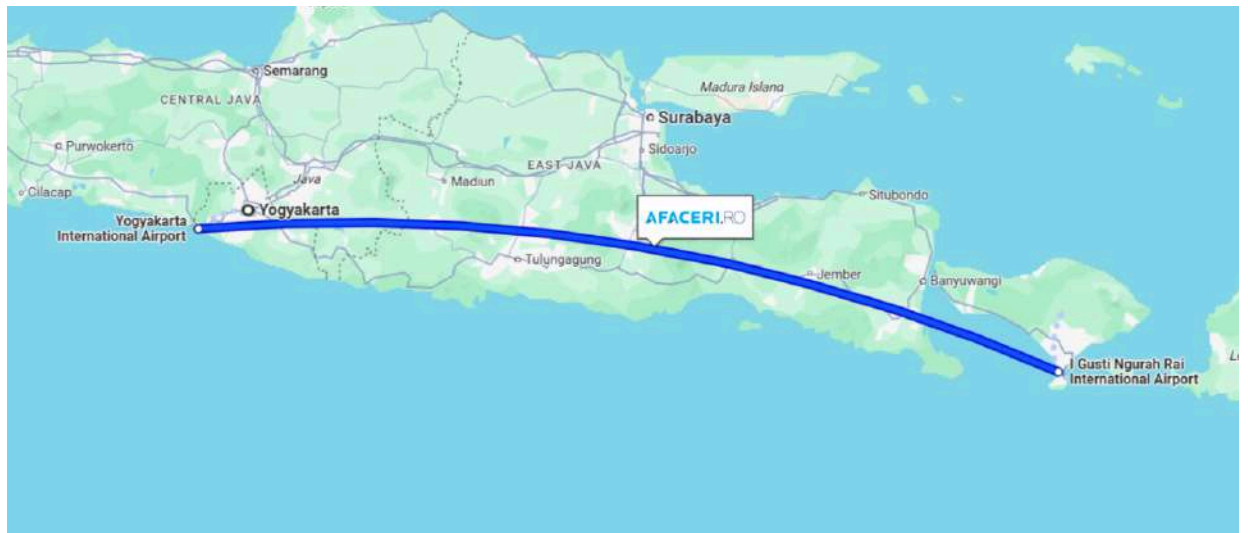

The temple is located between two other temples, both of which were also built during the 9th century, in a straight line which suggests a deeper symbolic meaning behind the construction. The temple is made out of volcanic rock and each side of the stairs and the top of the gates are carved Kala-Makara, which is widely found in traditional Javanese temples. Other than around 700 monkeys, guests can also see 186 species of trees in 12.5 hectares of forest. Grab lunch at a restaurant like Warung Makan Merta Sari for authentic Balinese dishes such as Nasi Campur (mixed rice) or Sate Lilit (minced fish satay). After eating, browse the shops for local crafts or souvenirs like Balinese textiles or handmade jewelry—a perfect way to spend a leisurely hour.</p>	<p>Optional: Transfer to Tanah Lot temples.</p> <p>Visit Tanah Lot, the most beautiful and famous temples in Bali.</p>  <p>Due to its location on a huge rock on the sea, it's considered a unique place. 
